

CIVITAS INSTITUTE NORTH CAROLINA STATEWIDE STUDY / JULY 12-13, 2011

Recently the state legislature passed the Medical Malpractice reform legislation that capped the amount of 'pain and suffering' damages that could be awarded in a medical malpractice lawsuit, while still allowing economic damages, future medical care and personal expenses to be awarded in the full amount. Supporters say this bill will lower health care costs and increase the number of doctors practicing in high risk areas such as delivering babies. Opponents say limiting the amount of non-economic damages is unfair and the amount that is given should be left up to juries. Governor Perdue vetoed this bill.
