Bill and Phil,

After checking with the Buncombe CBE I provide the following information.

Buncombe CBE has received no complaints from voters about provisional ballots.

The Buncombe CBE utilizes the procedure described in the memo you referenced to assist the poll workers to locate properly registered voters so that the voter does not have to vote a provisional ballot. This has been used successfully in previous elections and greatly reduced the number of provisional ballots that would have been required because the poll worker was unable to correctly search the VR database.

The Director of elections has informed me that hundreds of provisional ballots have been authorized by CBE staff because most of the provisional voters were not registered to vote in Buncombe County or even in North Carolina.

As for the three incidents detailed in the report below, provisional ballots would be the proper procedure, however, facts provided indicates the voters are not properly registered and qualified to vote in Buncombe County and the provisional ballots would not/could not be counted.

Poll observer Linda Southard reported the following incident that occurred at about 10:45 or 11:00 AM on Election Day:

A young woman named Natasha Blevins advised one of the judges that she had moved out of the precinct. However, she was given a regular ballot and allowed to vote at the Reynolds Fire Department precinct. It appears that she should have been given a provisional ballot or directed to a different precinct. The poll observer called the Romney Legal Team and did not challenge the vote.

Linda reported that following this initial incident she made several other observations, all of them between 10:45 AM - 11:45 AM:

1. A woman with the last name Espinoza who appeared to be registered in Cumberland County was given a provisional ballot. The judge explained that since she had been a resident of Buncombe County for more than six months and had an envelope addressed to her in Buncombe County, she was allowed to vote by provisional ballot.
2. A disabled man named William Dirk Bocoook who appeared to be registered in Henderson County was not allowed to vote. His mother brought him to the Reynolds Fire Department precinct and argued that he should be able to vote there.
3. A young man who appeared to be registered in Madison County was not allowed to vote.

Linda showed me a two-page memo entitled SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2012 GENERAL ELECTION that seemed to contain instructions to poll workers from the Board of Elections. The memo included the following statement on page 2:

"Remember that we need you to call and get authorization from the BOE office, BEFORE voting someone provisionally."

Attached is a map of Warren Wilson College. You can see the line that goes through the campus. The contests that this affects are NC House District 114 and NC House District 115 and Buncombe County Commissioner District 1 and County Commissioner District 2.

So far there are 85 people that have voted. Out of the 85, we have 23 absentee by mail, 19 Civilian and 4 overseas.

We have contacted all 18 onestop sites and have instructed them that for any voter that comes into vote with 701 Warren Wilson Road, that the site calls the office so that we can determine what side of the campus that they are on and we will assign them the appropriate ballot style. We have also instructed them to have the voter vote provisionally, since the address for the college is not currently in the system.
